EBC 3, 2, 1! – On Location in 2026! Leading to Worship Sunday March 29, 2026

Reading: Matthew 21:1-11

EBC focuses on bringing the Bible into our Everyday Lives, emphasizing God's Everyday presence by finding connections in our physical world! Three points, two questions, and one action step!

Three Points

- Human praise is unstable, but God's faithfulness is not. The same crowds who celebrate Jesus on Sunday will reject him by Friday. Lutherans name this honestly: human hearts are changeable, but God's promise is steady.
- Jesus enters Jerusalem knowing full well what is coming and he goes anyway. This is pure grace. Christ's mission is not dependent on public approval. He rides in as the humble king who saves *in spite of* human betrayal, not because of human support.
- Holy Week reveals both our unfaithfulness and God's unwavering commitment to us. Lutherans hold these two truths together: we are sinners and saints, capable of both praise and rejection, yet Christ remains faithful, carrying the cross for the very people who turn on him.

Two Questions

- When have you found yourself cheering for Jesus' blessings but hesitating when his way leads toward sacrifice, humility, or courage?
- How does it change your understanding of God to realize that Jesus stays faithful even when we are inconsistent, confused, or afraid?

Action Step

- Choose one place this week where your faith feels shaky or inconsistent, and name it to God, trusting that Christ remains faithful even there.

Don't like these questions? Do these verses say something different to you? Great! What it is?
