Welcome to this week's EBC 3,2,1! Three points, two questions, and one action step!

Three Points

- Christ comes to us in fear—not after we fix ourselves. The disciples are hiding behind locked doors, afraid. Jesus does not wait for courage or faith to return - he enters into their fear and speaks, "Peace be with you."
- Jesus meets Thomas where he is, not where he "should be". Thomas doubts, and instead of rebuking him, Jesus offers exactly what Thomas needs - physical proof.
- The risen Christ sends and equips us through Word and Sacrament. Jesus breathes on the disciples and gives them the Holy Spirit, sending them out with a mission of forgiveness.

Two Questions

- Where in your life do you feel like the disciples, afraid, uncertain, or "behind locked doors" and how might Christ be present there even now?
- Like Thomas, what do you find yourself needing from Jesus in order to trust more deeply and how might he already be meeting you in that need?

Action Step

Each day, pause and reflect on one moment where peace, reassurance, or grace showed up, especially if it surprised you.

Don't like these questions? Do these verses say something different to you? Great! What it is?
