EBC 3, 2, 1! – On Location in 2026! Leading to Worship Sunday April 19, 2026

Reading: Luke 24:13-35

EBC focuses on bringing the Bible into our Everyday Lives, emphasizing God's Everyday presence by finding connections in our physical world! Three points, two questions, and one action step!

Three Points

- It is still Easter Sunday, when two people are walking on the road to Emmaus. We hear that they are "disciples," but as far as we know, they do not appear to be any of the persons we commonly think of as "the twelve." Jesus meets them and walks with them, but the two walkers do not recognize Jesus – he seems only a "stranger."
- The walkers tell about Jesus' being handed over by the chief priests, and about his death. They also express sorrow and disappointment; they are brave enough to tell this "stranger" they had hoped Jesus would be the one to save them from the Romans.
- When they near their village, they invite this stranger to dinner, and when Jesus breaks the bread to share with them, they finally see – They have been talking to Jesus this whole time!

Two Questions

- Why do you think Luke makes such a point of telling us that it took so long for the two disciples to recognize Jesus? How do you "know" when you are seeing Jesus in your Everyday Life? What is it in your life that tells you God is with you?
- Luke does not say that Jesus is repeating the last supper with these disciples, but it is still clearly when Jesus is "breaking bread" with them that they recognize Jesus. Was it the "sharing of gifts" that helped? Or the simple act of being together over a meal? Was it an echo of the last supper? What things remind you of Jesus, and remind you to look for Jesus?

Action Step

- Look for Jesus this week in places you are not necessarily seeing him at first glance. He is there, walking with you!

Don't like these questions? Do these verses say something different to you? Great! What it is?
