EBC 3, 2, 1! – On Location in 2026! Leading to Worship Sunday April 26, 2026

Reading: John 10:1-10

EBC focuses on bringing the Bible into our Everyday Lives, emphasizing God's Everyday presence by finding connections in our physical world! This week, we embrace being sheep – not necessarily as just meek and needy, but as individuals following Jesus where we are called by name! Three Points

- In John 10, Jesus describes himself as the good shepherd. Others will sneak in over fences, but Jesus will enter by the gate. Jesus calls his own sheep by name and he leads them out.
- Jesus goes ahead of his sheep and the sheep follow him. The sheep know Jesus' voice, and they follow Jesus, not the strangers sneaking in over the fences.
- Whoever enters through Jesus will be saved and will come in and go out and find the pasture. Jesus comes as the shepherd so that we may have life and have it abundantly.

Two Questions

- Who or what are the people or things in your life Jesus figuratively describes as sneaking in over the fences? How do you focus on following Jesus, instead of moving toward the people or things we shouldn't?
- When you think of "sheep" as a figurative animal for us as Jesus' followers, what do you picture? Do you picture docile, meek creatures, merely waiting and needing protection? What if we focus on sheep giving of themselves (their wool), following where Jesus leads, to help do the things Jesus has in mind for us? Can you picture Jesus calling you individually through the gate to go where he wants you to serve? Where is Jesus leading?

Action Step

- Let yourself be all kinds of sheep! Be a needy creature, letting Jesus care for you. And be a helping creature, giving of yourself where Jesus calls you to be!
