Reading: Acts 2:1-21

EBC focuses on bringing the Bible into our Everyday Lives, emphasizing God's Everyday presence by finding connections in our physical world! Three Points

- The Holy Spirit comes to ordinary people gathered together, showing that God works through community and not only through leaders or the powerful.
- The miracle of many languages at Pentecost reveals God's desire to bring people together across cultures, nations, and differences rather than forcing everyone into sameness.
- Peter points to God's promise that the Spirit is poured out on *all people* — young and old, women and men, servants and free — emphasizing God's inclusive grace and calling.

Two Questions

- Where do you see the Holy Spirit creating understanding, unity, or new life in places that often feel divided?
- What gifts or voice might God be calling you to use more boldly for the sake of your community and neighbor?

Action Step

- Make a deliberate effort to listen to and learn from someone whose background, generation, culture, or experience is different from your own, trusting that the Holy Spirit speaks through many voices.
