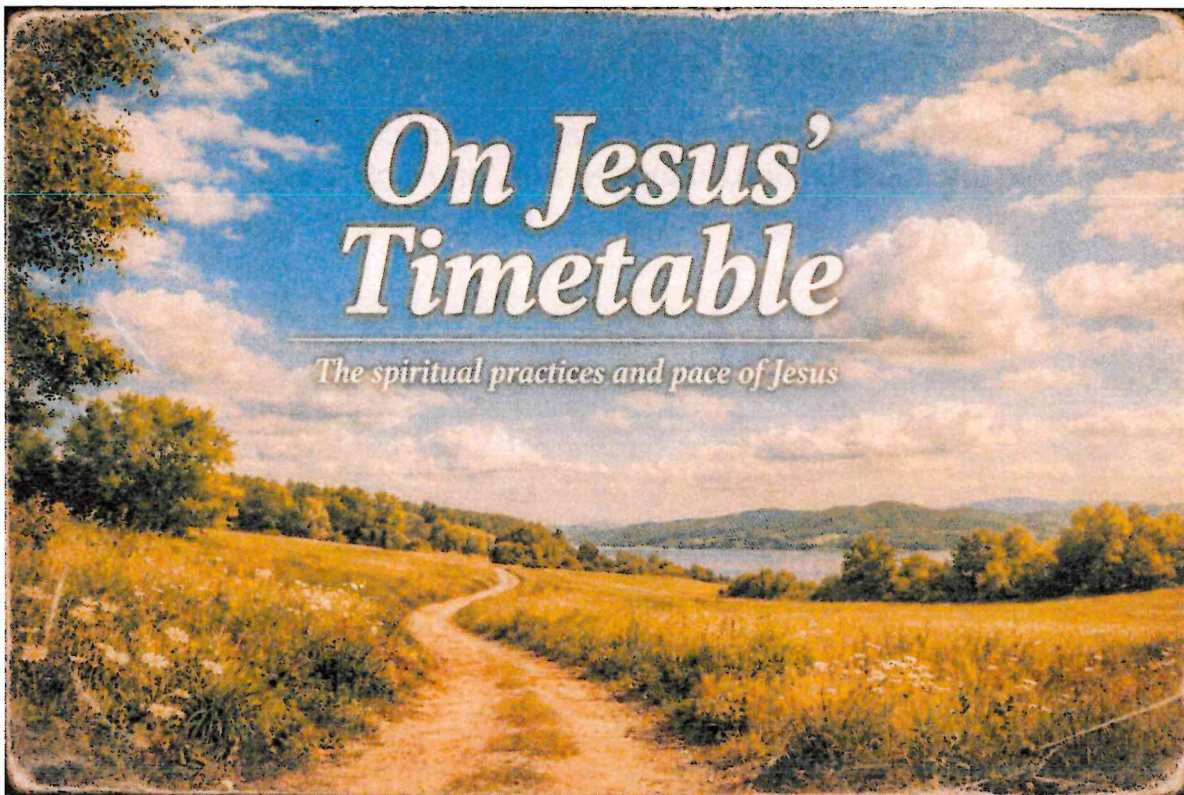

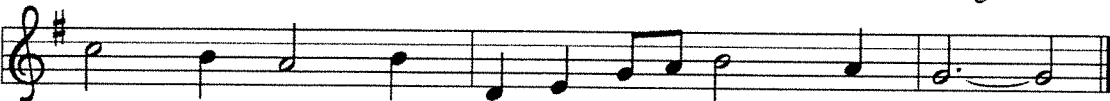

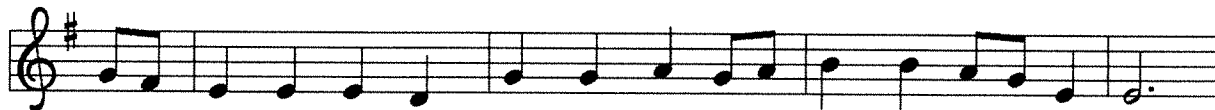
PRAYER OF THE DAY

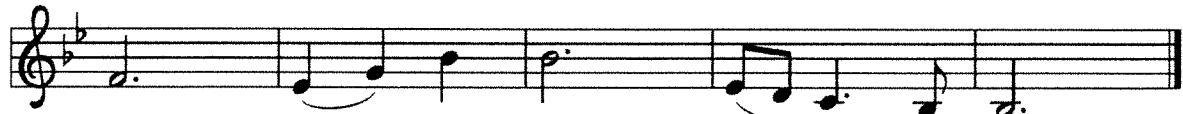
