Welcome to this week's EBC 3,2,1! Three points, two questions, and one action step!

Three Points

- Jesus calls Levi where he is, then accepts Levi's hospitality by pulling up a chair at his table, showing that God's grace meets people before they have everything figured out.
- Around Levi's table, people are free to be themselves. Jesus creates a space where those often judged or excluded are welcomed with dignity instead of shame.
- Christian hospitality is more than opening a door—it is pulling up a chair, making room for others, and trusting that relationships can become places where God's love is experienced.

Two Questions

- Who in your life might need someone to pull up a chair and simply be present with them, without trying to fix or change them?
- What helps create spaces where people feel safe enough to be their authentic selves, knowing they are welcomed and valued?

Action Step

- Pull up a chair for someone this week by sharing a meal, inviting them into conversation, or intentionally making space for them to belong just as they are.
