Three points, two questions, and one action step!

Three Points

- God calls Abram to leave what is familiar and step "off the map," trusting that God will guide the journey even when the destination is unknown.
- God's call is not simply about going somewhere new; it is about becoming a blessing so that others experience God's love and promise through us.
- Faith often means following God into new ventures, relationships, or opportunities where we cannot see the whole path but trust that God is already at work.

Two Questions

- Where might God be inviting you to step "off the map" and trust God's leading instead of your own certainty?
- How could embracing an unfamiliar opportunity become a way for you to be a blessing to someone else?

Action Step

- Take one faithful step into something new this week—a conversation, opportunity, act of service, or challenge you've been hesitant to embrace—and ask how God might use that step to bless others.
