Welcome to this week's EBC 3,2,1! Three points, two questions, and one action step!

Three Points

- Jesus challenges the religious leaders to look beyond appearances and recognize that God is already at work in unexpected people and places.
- The kingdom of God is not only something we wait for—it is something we can recognize and celebrate in the ordinary moments of our lives when Christ is present among us.
- To "feast" is to pause and notice God's goodness: sharing a meal, laughing with friends, welcoming someone, or celebrating a moment can all become ways of recognizing Christ's presence.

Two Questions

- Where do you already see Christ showing up in the ordinary moments of your life?
- What would it look like to slow down and "feast" more often—to intentionally celebrate God's presence instead of always rushing to the next thing?

Action Step

- Find one ordinary moment this week to **feast and celebrate**: share a meal, gather with friends, enjoy something beautiful, or simply pause with gratitude, and intentionally recognize Christ's presence in that moment.
